Grounds and Greens - Burned a lot of the brush/tree piles, will have to push remains together and move trees from #4 tee box to burn area. The bank mower blew a hydraulic line and made a mess on the blacktop, but was cleaned up and hose fixed in house.

The new driving mats are installed.

The new grass seed has finally germinated and is growing in well on the course.

Buildings - Will be putting in a standard walk-in door in the maintenance garage so the building can be out of the elements in bad weather when workers come and go. Also will be fixing the missing shingles on the roof.

The roof on the clubhouse also has some missing shingles for about the 3rd year in a row. A motion was made to put on a new steel roof by Conzett, 2nd by Laurizen and passed. The cost will be around \$10,000.

The south porch/stairs will get stained by Steines and Schmidt and new hand rails will be installed as the current ones has some rough spots and persons could get slivers.

Looking at possibly expanding the back grill area by putting more cement in.

Bar and Grill - The new stove and cash register have been purchased. Looking at ordering a few new round tables for the club house - around \$1000.

Cindy Gilbert has been doing a great job with the can money and purchased 2 new tables for the outdoor patio area. Thanks for all your help Cindy. The club purchased 8 new chairs for the tables.

Old business - Will be trading in 6 to 7 old golf carts to be replaced.

Doug Schmidt donated some old golf cart rims so we can have spare wheels/tires to fix flats and get the carts in service faster. Thanks Doug.

New Business - In the 65 and over tournament, a golfer was hit by another golf cart and broke a bone in his leg, he refused the ambulance.
